



Cynthia Esposito Lamy answers that question in American **Children in Chronic Poverty: Complex Risks, Benefit-Cost Analyses, and Untangling the Knot** by describing the complex and interacting "knot" of problems that **children** face as they grow up in **poverty**. Through a vast store of research on topics related to **children**, families and **poverty**, and methods to estimate "social return on investment," Lamy determines which programs and policies produce benefits that exceed costs, providing evidence for an efficient fight against **poverty**. Specific expert policy recommendations for keeping **poverty** from ruining **children's** potential are described within three broad themes: bringing equity to our educational system, supporting families as they transition through difficulties, and making work pay. Lamy concludes with foundational concepts for building an overarching model of **poverty**-fighting to bring separate, narrowly defined programs and policies together. Benefit-cost analysis confirms what the great religions have been trying to tell us for millennia: when we respect and care for the most vulnerable members of our society we create a strong, successful society in which everyone prospers
